Electronic Medical Record

The nursing staff is completing another step to have our medical records completely computerized. Starting August 2nd, the nurses on Dakota Rose South are using electronic recording for the documentation of the medications and treatments delivered to residents. The medications are all stored in locked drawers in the resident's room. This new process will be implemented in all of the communities at Rosewood in September.

Medication Dispensing

The new medication-dispensing project is very close to being implemented. The medications will be dispensed for each resident by a dispensing machine that looks like a vending machine. The pharmacy and the nursing staff are working closely to implement this in September on Dakota Rose South and then for all residents in October. When both of these processes are implemented, Rosewood will have one of the safest medication delivery system available and the first in the area.

Call Lights

The long awaited new call light system is being installed at this time. This new system will allow us a quite environment for our residents, quicker response to call lights, and a tracking system to evaluate timely responses. The new call light system will alert the caregiver by pager that the call light is activated. The time the call light is activated and the response time will be electronically documented.

Yes... technology is alive and well at Rosewood on Broadway and these three new implementations will enhance the quality and safety for residents.

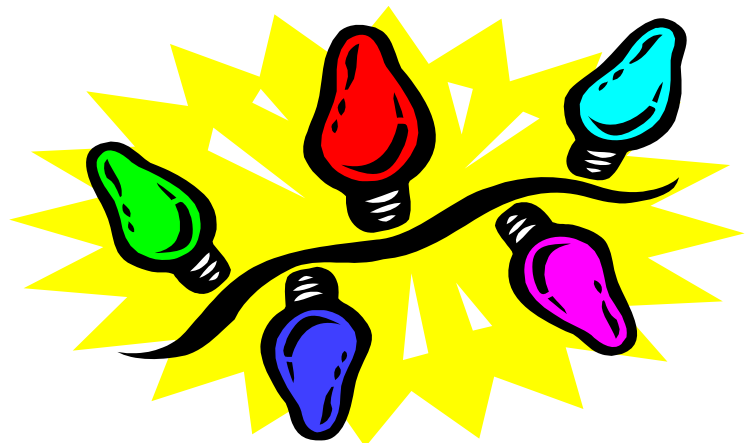

MOVE TO MDS 3.0

Beginning October 1, 2010, the Minimum Data Set (MDS) assessment that determines a resident's rate classification is changing. Some of the questions have changed but many remain the same. A great deal of the assessment is now done by interviewing the resident rather than by staff input, giving each resident a greater voice in their care. Also there is greater emphasis on pain management and discharge planning.

The part that individuals will notice is that there will be a change in the resident's rate when therapy is started and when it stops. Previously, even if therapy stopped, the rate did not change (decrease) until the next regularly scheduled rate assessment date. Now, when therapy stops, the rate will change to include only the other items of the assessment that go into determining the rate. Residents or their representatives will receive a different type of Classification Notice depending on the reason for the rate change.

Another change in the assessment process, is that items done in the hospital prior to admission or a hospital return, are no longer included in the assessment. These items included IV's, oxygen, etc.
